

**HomeCARE's Alternative Family Living (AFL) Providers** are skilled in working with children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. AFL Providers are trained not only in general interventions and activities but also in the individual's specific needs. **HomeCARE's AFL Providers** will ensure that the individual has the opportunity to learn new skills to promote independent living. **HomeCARE's AFL provider** will support skill development to improve daily living skills, socialization skills and development of leisure time interests and activities.

AFL placements are funded through the Innovation Waiver. LME/MCOs will authorize and coordinate the placement. **HomeCARE** contracts with Smoky Mountain Center and Partners, the local LME/MCOs. **HomeCARE** also has contracts with other LME/MCOs across North Carolina.

**HomeCare believes that a caring family setting is best practice.** Often, people with intellectual or developmental disabilities live with their family as long as they can. Alternative Family Living serves as a great option in lieu of placement in large institutions or nursing homes that cannot provide equivocal family principles.
